CHECK OUT OUR SHORT LIST OF REQUIREMENTS:

- All new students must be 3 or 4
 years old by September 1st of the
 school year you are applying for.
 We give preference to 3 year-olds.
- Students must live in the Reynolds School District. We give preference to families also living within the Alder Elementary School boundary.
- 35 of our 45 student spaces must meet income eligibility of 200% or less of the Federal Poverty Level.

We work to increase equity in preschools, and give priority to families based on their specific needs and circumstances.

We are a tuition–free program, thanks to funding from Preschool Promise, Preschool For All, and to our partnership with the Reynolds School District.

We use the Montessori system of education to prepare our young students for school and life. Montessori is based on the common needs of all growing children.
